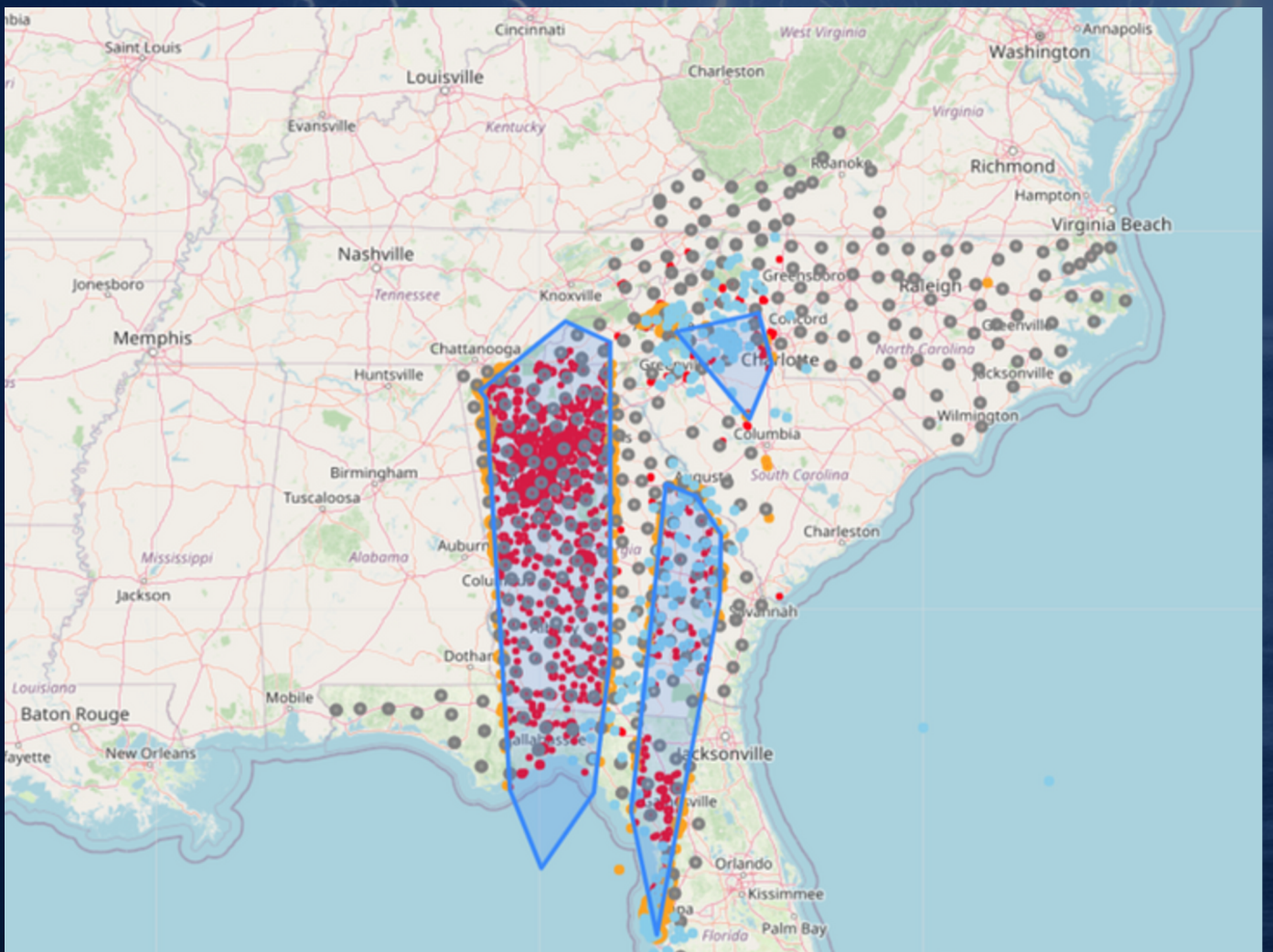

Why are there more properties potentially damaged in Georgia than other states?
 After slamming Florida on Sept. 27, 2024, Helene moved rapidly inland and was mostly over Georgia, bringing hurricane-forced winds, relentless rain, and severe flooding as far inland as Atlanta. The state was on the hurricane's direct path, resulting in more properties being potentially damaged.

CORE & BUFFER ZONES EXPLAINED

The disaster data set from Veros combines data and satellite imagery from multiple sources in near real-time, indicating whether or not a specific parcel has been affected. This disaster data provides accuracy more precise than FEMA, which uses county boundaries for its designations. Using parcel boundaries, latitude and longitude, address information and more, Veros creates two geographic areas that pertain to a disaster event: residential properties in the Core (inside the event) and residential properties in the Buffer (typically within a ½ mile outside of the core).
